

Virtual Workshop: Intro to Embroidery, with Jennifer Lamontagne

Class Description:

Want to learn embroidery or refresh your embroidery skills? Learn how to transfer patterns to fabric, basic embroidery stitches, and how to finish your hoop to hang on a wall. During this class, you will create and bring home a sampler to hang on your wall or keep for reference for your future embroidery projects. Stitches taught include: running stitch, back stitch, split stitch, satin stitch, chain stitch, seed stitch, and french knots.
